We support the ministries of the Good Samaritan Church in Ocna Mures, Romania and two Christian orphanages run by Ecce-Homo in Cluj Napoca, Romania. The Good Samaritan church run Sanctuary Orphanage, Gypsy children feeding programmes and work with poor widows and women in local prisons.

Fundraising and Donations



We have again been able to give £500 to the widows' ministry, which is going to provide food parcels, we hope this will help to relieve the strain the poor feel every winter in trying to afford both food and heating. This money has helped 27 widows. We have also been able to buy every child at Sanctuary Orphanage a Christmas present of slippers and jumpers.



Our back to school campaign went very well, and every child in Ecce-homo's orphanages received a back pack full of stationary, shoes, clothes toiletries and other gifts. We also gave coats to every child that needed a new one this winter – and if you contributed you should have received a letter with thanks directly from the children and photos. Visit update from Shirley Robberts

Although my daughter Tish had been to visit and help the Good Samaritan Church in Romania and she had told me so much about her experiences, nothing could have prepared me for when I went out there last November. The poverty in some parts of the country is unbelievable! The children in the gypsy villages, well I wanted to bring them all home, they are so poor and hungry.

We helped at all the feeding programmes that the church ran. We visited a hospital where there were very sick elderly people. They are given only very basic care, some we prayed with, some we just held their hands and cried with. We also visited some widows and gave them warm coats and clothes because they do not have enough money for the essentials – they were very appreciative.



The orphans in the orphanage were such lovely children and although they have no father and mother to care for them, the staff that look after them are such lovely Christians they seem to be happy and well cared for.

The church who support all these ministries are amazing and tireless, but what challenged me most was how much by prayer and great faith they cry out to the Lord for all their needs and He always answers and provides . You can see the joy of the Lord in them in the midst of such a sad county. It certainly was a life changing experience and I feel compelled to do all I can to continue to support the work of Heart Response in it's work in Ocna Mures.

The orphanage struggles somewhat with workers only staying for a short time; please pray that God would put the right people here to work with the children long term and that they can build up good relationships that show the love of God.
